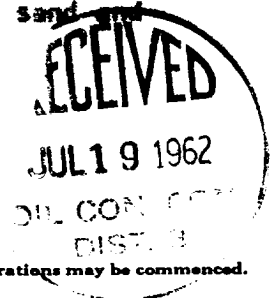

DETAILS OF WORK

Subject well spudded May 17, 1962. Set 100' of 8 5/8" surface casing and cemented with 50 sacks. Total depth of 3340' reached May 22, 1962. 4 1/2" casing set at 3290' and cemented with 100 sacks. Well was perforated at the interval 3260' to 3280' and sand fraced with 30,000 sand and 20,000 gallons of water on July 9, 1962.

Well presently awaiting testing.
