In the event these records are unobtainable, or if it appears the well was improperly plugged, we may have to re-enter, drill out and re-plug it.



I do not have any records in regards to the subject well; however, as I recall, the well was drilled by Shar-Alan Oil Co. and then probably sold to Dyna Ray Oil & Gas, Inc. Dyna Ray changed their name to Trans-Delta. I understand that Trans-Delta later sold their interest in this area to Petro-Lewis Corp.

I worked for a short time for Dyna Ray and I don't believe that the well was plugged during this period. If anyone has records on this well, it is probably Petro-Lewis. Sorry I can't be of any more help.
