Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of June 28, 1957, wherein you requested an exception to the well spacing requirements of Commission Rule 104 (b) for the above-captioned well, said exception being occasioned by a resurvey of the lines of Section 27, Township 24 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. This resurvey established the well's true location as being 587 feet from the south line and 1395 feet from the east line of Section 27 rather than 790 feet from the south line and 1708 feet from the east line as was originally intended.

Inasmuch as this location was staked in good faith using a copy of the original survey map of the year 1882, and the location is orthodox according to the original maps, the Commission hereby grants administrative exception to the spacing requirements of Rule 104 (b).
