Our efforts were successful on the Jicarilla 37-B #4, resulting in an increase in the production of approximately four to one. Should you have need of a test after workover, please have Brad Keyes, or Bill Latch make the test, and send a statement to me.

I understood, in the beginning, that the U. S. G. S. office at Durango would send copies of these reports to you. Apparently it did not, hence I am also enclosing a copy of Form 9-331, Notice of Intention, and Form 9-331, Subsequent report, on each of the following wells:-

Jicarilla 37B #1, and Jicarilla 13 #2, and a copy of the Bond Log by Welx, which I ran on the 37B #1.

We were not very successful on either of these two wells, as the production after the workover was approximately the same as before the workover. The copy of my transmittal letter to Jerry Long, Subsequent Report on the 37B #1 will give you an idea of the problems we encountered on this well.
