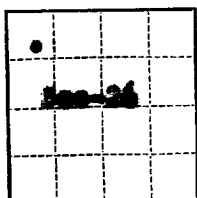

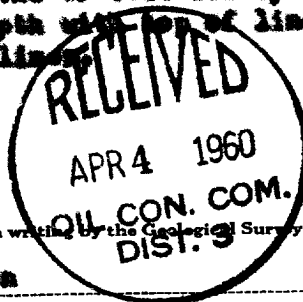

## DETAILS OF WORK

- 4-1-55 - 4620' TD: 4240' FSD: (15-Sack cement plug from 4329'-4240')  
 3-3-55 - 10-3/4" OD 32.75W, N40, REM Csg. set at 212' with 200 Sacks, Int. Circulated.  
 3-27-55 - 6-5/8" OD 24W, J55 & 200 Casing, set at 4460' with 300 sacks cement.  
 (Open hole from 4460'-4620') Temporarily abandoned 4/9/55.

Propose to squeeze off perforations from 4395' to 4312' and 4390' to 4420', and drill from 4420' to 7000' or sufficient depths to test Gallup and Dakota Zones. If productive set 4 1/2" OD liner from total depth with top of liner set at 4395' with sufficient amount of cement to circulate liner.
