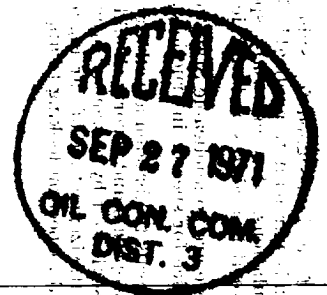

Instructions
