REESE & ASSOC., INC., FOR PERMISSION TO EFFECT DUAL COMPLETION OF ITS MESA WELL NO. 1-25, LOCATED IN THE NW/4 NW/4 OF SECTION 25, TOWNSHIP 24 NORTH, RANGE 7 WEST, NMPM, RIO ARriba COUNTY, NEW MEXICO, IN SUCH A MANNER AS TO PERMIT THE PRODUCTION OF GAS FROM AN UNDESIGNATED GALLUP POOL ADJACENT TO THE DEVILS FORK-GALLUP GAS POOL AND THE PRODUCTION OF GAS FROM AN UNDESIGNATED DAKOTA POOL.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A (c) Val R. Reese & Assoc., Inc., made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on August 1, 1960 for permission to dually complete its Mesa Well No. 1-25, located in the NW/4 NW/4 of Section 25, Township 24 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from an undesignated Gallup Pool adjacent to the Devils Fork-Gallup Gas Pool and the production of gas from an undesignated Dakota Pool.

NOW, on this 22nd day of August, 1960, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Subsection 'c' of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Val R. Reese & Assoc., Inc., be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Mesa Well No. 1-25, located in the NW/4 NW/4 of Section 25, Township 24 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from an undesignated Gallup Pool adjacent to the Devils Fork-Gallup Gas Pool and the production of gas from an undesignated Dakota Pool, through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section V, Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Dakota Zone.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Val R. Reese & Assoc., Inc.,  
be and the same is hereby authorized to drill complete the New  
Well No. 1-25, located in the NW1/4 of Section 25, Township  
25 North, Range 7 West, T12N, R7W, Arizpa County, New Mexico, in  
such a manner as to permit the production of gas from an undesignated  
Gas Pool adjacent to the Devils Tongue Gas Pool and  
the production of gas from an undesignated Gas Pool, through  
parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete operations  
and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of section  
V, Rule 113-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take proper  
precautions upon completion and annually thereafter during the  
primary period for the term hereof.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained by the Commission for such further order or orders as may seem necessary or convenient for the prevention of waste and/or protection of correlative rights; upon failure of applicant to comply with any requirement of this order, the Commission may terminate the authority hereby granted and require applicant or its successors and assigns to limit its activities to regular single-zone production in the interests of conservation.
