

THE APPLICATION OF SOCONY MOBIL
OIL COMPANY FOR A DUAL COMPLETION.

CASE NO. NC-1512

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
TO THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-1, Socony Mobil Oil Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on June 28, 1964, for permission to dual complete its Jicarilla Utro well No. 11-28 located in Unit 4 of section 24, Township 24 North, Range 5 West, NM-M, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce oil from the Gallup Formation adjacent to the Utro-Gallup Oil pool and gas from the Basin-Bakota pool.

Now, on this 13th day of July, 1964, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-1 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste or impair corrective rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

That the applicant herein, Socony Mobil Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dual complete its Jicarilla Utro well No. 11-28 located in Unit 4 of section 24, Township 24 North, Range 5 West, NM-M, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce oil from the Gallup formation adjacent to the Utro-Gallup oil pool and gas from the Basin-Bakota pool through parallel strings of tubing.

NOTWITHSTANDING However, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-1.

REVIEW PERIOD. That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the annual deliverability Test period for the Basin-Bakota pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
