

THE APPLICATION OF MOCONY MOBIL
OIL COMPANY FOR A DUAL COMPLETION.

ORDER NO. MC-1512

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-a Mocony Mobil Oil Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on June 22, 1964, for permission to dually complete its Hicarilla Otero well No. 11-28 located in Unit 1 of section 28, Township 24 North, Range 5 West, N44W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce oil from the Gallup Formation adjacent to the Otero-Gallup Oil Pool and gas from the Basin-Lakota Pool.

Now, on this 13th day of July, 1964, the Secretary-Director finds:

(1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-a of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;

(2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and

(3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.

(4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste or impair correlative rights.

(5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Mocony Mobil Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Hicarilla Otero well No. 11-28 located in Unit 1 of section 28, Township 24 North, Range 5 West, N44W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce oil from the Gallup formation adjacent to the Otero-Gallup Oil Pool and gas from the Basin-Lakota Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

REVISED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-a.

REVISED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test period for the Basin-Lakota Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
