7-1-64 Drilled 7-7/8" hole to 6845'. Run logs. Ran (6844') 168 jts. - 5-1/2" 15.5# - J-55 csg. guideshoe at 6844' & fillup collar at 6807'. Cemented 5-1/2" csg. at 6844' with 135 sax Class "A" cement. No press. on csg.

Perf. csg. with 4 holes at 5900', 8 holes at 6392-6401' & 6779-6781', 4 holes at 6565 and 4 holes at 6835'.

7-7-64 Squeezed 110 sax Class "A" Cement with 0.2% R-5 at 6400'. Press. tested to 3800 psi.

7-13-64 Squeezed 50 sax Class "A" cement with 1% D-19 in stages at 6565'. Press. tested to 4000#. Held O.K.

7-14-64 Squeezed 50 sax Class "A" cement at 5900' in stages. Press. tested to 3000#, held O.K.

7-15-64 Squeezed 25 Sax Class "A" Cement at 6780' & 6835'. Press. tested to 3000#, held O.K.

7-19-64 Perf. 4 holes 6787'. Squeezed 25 sax Class "A" cement. with 1% D-19 at 6787'. Press. tested to 4000# for 30 min. O.K.

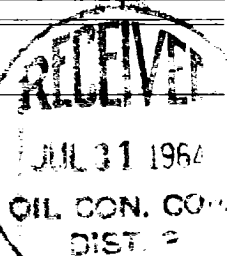

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices. In addition, such proposals and reports should include reasons for the abandonment; data on any former or present productive zones, or other zones with present significant fluid contents not sealed off by cement or otherwise; depths (top and bottom) and method of placement of cement plugs; mud or other material placed below, between and above plugs; amount, size, method of parting of any casing, liner or tubing pulled and the depth to top of any left in the hole; method of closing top of well; and date well site conditioned for final inspection looking to approval of the abandonment.
