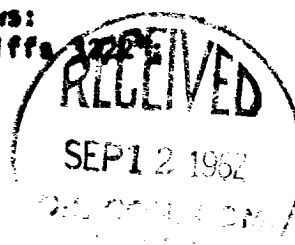

DETAILS OF WORK

Subject well spudded July 28, 1962. 8 5/8" surface casing set at 97' and cemented with 60 sacks. Total depth of 3300' reached July 31, 1962. Set 4 1/2" casing at 3298' and cemented with 75 sacks. Well perforated from 3250' to 3265' with 2 shots per ft. Sand fraced August 27, 1962 with 34000 gallons of water and 30,000# sand. Electric Log tops as follows: Ojo Alamo 2870'; Kirtland 3130'; Fruitland 3192'; Pictured Cliffs 3224' to 3258'.

Well presently awaiting testing.
