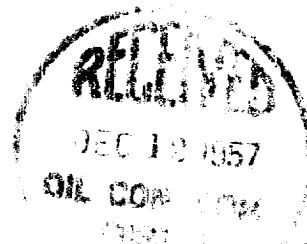

DETAILS OF WORK

The Federal 6-22 #1 was spudded on November 26, 1957. 8 5/8" surface casing was cemented at 411' w/ 225 sacks and the casing was tested w/ 1000 psi for 30 minutes w/ no loss of pressure after 48 hrs. At present the well is drilling ahead at 1958'.
