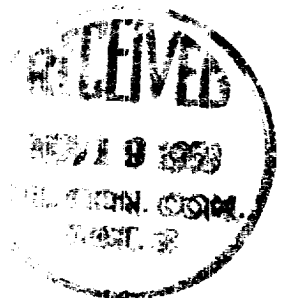
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A field inspection on November 16, 1959 indicates that the well which you were drilling in Unit A of Section 22, Township 24 North, Range 4 East, Rio Arriba County, is still flowing water through the wellbore. This is, as you know, a violation of our Rules and Regulations. Further we have determined from the field inspection that your rig has been moved to a new location approximately 7/10 of a mile to the West of the original location. The Oil Conservation Commission has not approved a Notice of Intention to Drill at this new location, nor do you have an approved bond on file for this well. Accordingly you are ordered to cease all drilling operations at the new location until such time as you have an approved C-101 for the well and an approved bond for this well, and until the original hole is properly plugged and the plugging is approved by our District Engineer.

Violation of this order will result in immediate court action.
