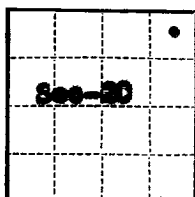

DETAILS OF WORK

5/2/62: Second Well Test with new equipment:  
Took 10 1/2 hour flow test. Pressure at start of test 2210#, taken by Dead Wt. Tester. Well had been closed in 48 hours prior to start of test.  
Opened well through New National 500,000 BTU Heater-Separator Unit on 12/64" Adj. Choke and gradually opened up to 16/64" Adj. Choke while regulating Heater-Separator Unit.  
Well stabilized last hour of test for Gas Volume Reading of 2.104 MCF/Daily on 16/64" Adjustable Choke, with flowing casing press. stabilized @ 1810# by Dead Wt. Tester. Made 14 Bbls. Distillate during last 7 hours of test, with Heater-Separator press. of 550#-600#.
