
Dear Mr. Kendrick:

I drove to Ghost Ranch yesterday for purposes of witnessing the plugging of the well in caption.

When I arrived the Halliburton people were in the process of completing the setting of the first plug which was done with 100 sacks of cement at 420 ft. to 80 ft. They were to wait 4 hours before setting the second one at 10 ft. to surface with 10 sacks. A 4 ft. pipe was to be placed on the surface.

The area around the well has not been leveled and I assured Mr. Storm's representative that the bond would not be released until surface conditions were acceptable to the land owners and to please let us know when an inspection could be made.
