*Enclosed is a supply of Forms C-102, C-103 and C-105, along with New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Rules and Regulations.*

*The following procedure should be followed in regard to plugging of the McKay Tidel well, N-14-24N-2W:*

*File Form C-105, Well Record form, indicating formations penetrated. Along with this a form C-102 indicating plugging plans may be filed. The rules require that plugs should be set so that all oil, gas and water is confined in the formation in which it occurred. Top plug and pipe marker extending at least four feet above ground level should also be set. After completion of plugging operations they should be reported on Form C-103 and it should also be indicated that pits were filled and the location levelled. You may proceed with plugging after receiving an approved copy of Form C-102.*

Enclosed is a copy of Form O-102, O-103 and O-104, along with the Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Rules and Regulations.

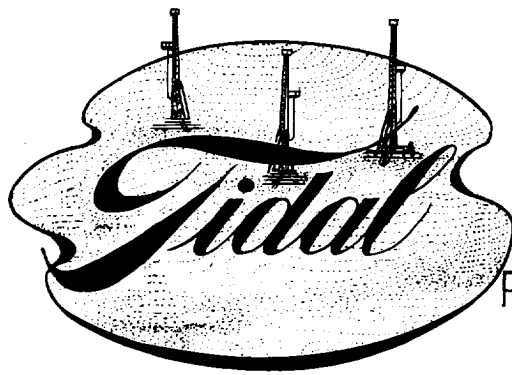
The following procedure should be followed in regard to filing of the Form O-102, O-103 and O-104.

File Form O-102, Well Record Form, indicating formation penetrated. Along with this a Form O-103, indicating casing depth may be filed. It is also required that depth should be set so that all oil, gas and water is contained in the formation in which it occurred. Log this and also marker extending at least four feet at the ground level should be set. After completion of filing the record they should be reported on Form O-103 and it should also be indicated that the well is filled and the location levelled. For all proceeds with filing after receiving an approved copy of Form O-102.


