August 9, 1977 Move in Astec Well Service, Cardwell Unit No. 34.
Tagged bottom with tubing at 2,442 feet; Total Depth 2,462 feet; 20 foot fill.
Pulled tubing (76 Joints) SLM; Tubing in good condition; 3 Joints show evidence
of corrosion. Ran sand pump. Cleaned out to bottom. Caught water sample on first
run for chemical analysis.

August 10th: Ran Welox Acoustic Cement Bond Log. Bond Good between upper and
lower sections of casing perforations. August 11th: Running tubing and packer;
Anchor joint 31 feet, packer 3 feet; Pin cracked on fourth collar above packer,
left dutchman in top of collar; Approximately 158 feet of fish in hole. Heavy
rainstorm flooded location and washed out culvert on access road. Culvert re-
built August 14th.

August 15th: Fishing; On first run recovered collar with dutchman in both ends.
August 16th: Fishing; On second run no recovery, lost overshot. On third run no
recovery, Released fisherman. August 17th: Running tubing; Landed tubing on top
of fish at approximately 2,293 feet. Heavy rainstorm washed out culvert on access
road. August 18th: Culvert re-built. Hooked up well and placed on production.
Released Astec Unit.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
