Drilled to 6905' TD. Ran 222 joints 5 1/2" casing, landed @ 6905' w/stage collar @ 4795' & metal petal basket @ 4764'. Cemented thru shoe w/85 sacks reg. & 85 cu.ft. Stratocrete w/2% gel followed w/75 sacks reg. Bumped plug w/1400# & checked float O.K. Cemented thru stage collar w/175 sacks reg. & 175 cu.ft. Stratocrete w/2% gel. Closed stage collar & tested w/2000# for 10 minutes O.K. WOC. Completing well 5-1-62
