

DETAILS OF WORK

TD 6905'. 5 1/2" casing at 6905'. Perforated 5 1/2" casing opposite Dakota with jets at 6848' and 6838'. Run tubing and sandfraced with 25,000# sand, 1050# AQUAMITE, and 560 bbls. of water mixed with 1% calcium chloride. Displaced with 170 bbls. of water with 1% calcium chloride. Rig released 5-1-62. Moved in swabbing unit, swabbed and tested well. IP 57 bbls. condensate and 3701 MCF gas per day based on test of 5-5-62 for 14 hours of 33 bbls. oil, 40 bbls. load water, and 2159 MCF gas flowing on 32/64" choke. Condensate is 62° gravity at 60° API.
