Gentlemen:

Field operating pressures noted during routine operations indicated a communication leak in a dual completion well, Northeast Haynes Apache Well No. 3, Unit letter P, Section 16, T24N, R5W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. Tubing was pulled from the well and the communication leak was found to be in the cross-over port which had cut out in the Baker Model MOE snap-set cross-over packer. The packer assembly was dressed and repaired and all equipment was run back in the well. Subsequent operating pressures indicate the communication leak was successfully repaired.

The Basin Dakota zone (lower) in the subject well is scheduled for the 1965 Deliverability test to commence on April 21, 1965. Permission is requested to commence with the scheduled test and to perform the required packer-leakage test immediately after, and in conjunction with the shut-in period of the Deliverability test.
