The U.S.G.S. has forwarded to us a copy of the Notice of Intention to Drill with attached plat on your #1 Cuccia well in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 14-24N-1W Rio Arriba County.

We note that you have dedicated 80 acres to this well. Since there is no 80-acre spacing approved for any gas wells in the San Juan Basin, you will have to either dedicate 160 acres to this well, or petition the Commission for hearing to approve a non-standard unit consisting of 80 acres.

No Form C-110 for production on this well can be approved until the above exceptions are taken care of.
