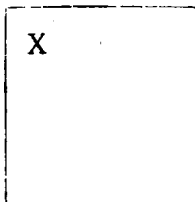

Second Stage: 50 sacks regular cement, 50 sacks Pozmix, 2% gel.

Two-stage collar at 2235'.

Held 1000#/30 Minutes.

Top of cement by temperature survey - second stage at 1725'.

Top of cement by calculation - first stage at 4514'.
