Gentlemen:

Please be advised that subject well has been completed by cementing 2-7/8" casing to the depth of 5824 feet. The Gallup zone was perforated from 5566-68, 5624-26, 5743-45, 5751-53 and subsequently fracked with 20,000 gallons water, 20,000# sand and 20 tons liquid CO₂. The well was potentialed on January 3, 1964, for 22.75 barrels oil per day with a COR of 4100 cubic feet per barrel. Well has leveled off at 13 BO/day after initial decline after frack treatment and appears to be capable of flowing through the 2-7/8 casing efficiently.

The rules and regulations of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission require administrative approval of tubingless completions below a depth of 5,000 feet. Due to the questionable economy of this well and due to the fact that it appears to be able to flow efficiently through the 2-7/8 casing, administrative approval of this tubingless completion is herewith requested.
