Ran cag corrosion log from 5000 to 3000', corrosion log indicated probable holes in cag at 3647' and 3655'. Set Baker Cast Iron BP at 5400'. Perf 4 holes at 4260' and 2 holes at 3647'. Ran and set Baker Retainer at 4092'. Cemented w/300 cu.ft. of Class C cement, good circulation. Reversed out approx 45 cu.ft. cmt. Press up and pumped approx 95 cu.ft. into perforation and corrosion holes 3647' for sqz. Max & Final press 1100 psi. Drilled cmt. Press tests: 3700', 800#, ok. 3812', 1000# drop to 500# in 15 min. 4092', 1000# drop to 300# in 3 min. 100# in 18 min. Pump in at 1000# w/rig pump. Ran Baker Full Bore Packer & set at 3747'. Pressured up to 2000#, bled off 500# in 5 min. Packer set @ 3139'. Sqd interval 3631-3684' w/132 ft of Class C cmt w/1.5% D60F & 2% CaCl₂. Max & Final Press 1600#. Drilled out from 3358' to 3700', tested cag w/1000#, ok. Drilled retainer @ 4092'. Drilled hard cmt to 4272'. Tested cag w/1000#, ok. CO to 5545'. Loaded hole w/oil & spotted 250 gals mud acid across perfor at 3514 to 3532'. Ran Baker Fullbore Pkr & set @ 5300'. SOF perfor 5514 to 5532' w/22, 260 gals oil & 20, 7000 20-40 ad w/friction reducer. Pump in press 4200 psig. ATP 4400 psig, MTP 4700 psig, AIR 8 BPM. Flushed w/1470 gals oil. BSIP 1400 psig. Ran 2 3/8" EUE, J-55 thg w/thg anchor to 5501'. Ran pump & rods, put well back on production.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
