

**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER**  
**OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION**

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, J. Gregory Merrion made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on September 7, 1967, for permission to dually complete his Edna Well No. 4 located in Unit H of Section 7, Township 24 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Ballard-Pictured Cliffs Pool through 2 7/8-inch casing and oil from the Devils Fork-Gallup Pool through 2-inch tubing run inside 4 1/2-inch casing, the casing strings cemented in a common well bore.

NOW, on this 18th day of September, 1967, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

That the applicant herein, J. Gregory Merrion, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete his Edna Well No. 4 located in Unit H of Section 7, Township 24 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Ballard-Pictured Cliffs Pool through 2 7/8-inch casing and oil from the Devils Fork-Gallup Pool through 2-inch tubing run inside 4 1/2-inch casing, the casing strings cemented in a common well bore.

**PROVIDED HOWEVER,** That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

**PROVIDED FURTHER,** That applicant shall take segregation tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Ballard-Pictured Cliffs Pool.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:**

That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL COMMISSION

Whereas the regulations of Rule 113-A of General Regulations  
of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission, adopted  
September 1, 1957, for permission to drill a well in the  
Well No. 1 located in Unit 8 of Section 7, Township 21 North,  
Range 1 East, T11N, R1E, New Mexico, is such a  
well as to produce gas from the natural gas zone of the  
reservoir and all from the same well.  
That the proposed well is located in a corner well of  
the unit.

That on this 15th day of September, 1957, the Secretary  
of the Commission.

(1) That the Commission has been duly notified under the provisions  
of Rule 113-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations.

(2) That the Commission's investigation has been completed and a  
certificate of interest has been duly notified and

(3) That no objections have been received within the prescribed  
period as prescribed by said rule.

(4) That the proposed well complies with all the provisions  
of the Commission's Rules and Regulations.

(5) That the completion of the proposed well is such a  
well as to produce gas from the natural gas zone of the  
reservoir and all from the same well.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, J. Gregory Harrison, do hereby  
authorize to drill a well in the Well No. 1 located  
in Unit 8 of Section 7, Township 21 North, Range 1 East, T11N, R1E,  
New Mexico, is such a well as to produce gas from the  
reservoir and all from the same well.  
That the proposed well is located in a corner well of  
the unit.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall comply with the provisions of Rule 113-A  
of the Commission's Rules and Regulations.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take all the necessary  
steps to complete the well within the prescribed period  
of the Commission's Rules and Regulations.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

That the completion of this well is such a well as to produce  
gas from the natural gas zone of the reservoir and all from the same well.

That the proposed well complies with all the provisions  
of the Commission's Rules and Regulations.
