DETAILS OF WORK

It is intended to drill a well through the Lower Gallup Formation using rotary tools and mud circulation. Possible productive intervals will be perforated and sandoil fractured. A two-stage collar will be set 100' below bottom of Pictured Cliffs and this zone cemented off.

8-5/8" at **160'** with **175** sacks cement circulated to surface.
4-1/2" at **5845'** with **150** sacks cement-first stage; **100** sacks cement - second stage.

Estimated top of cement-first stage **4775'**; second stage **180'**.

The **W/2 NW/4** of Section **8** is dedicated to this well.
