Dear Mr. Cove:

Reference is made to your letter of April 29, 1958 regarding filing of initial and/or annual tests on your #2 Bolack B well leaated in Unit K, Section 1-24N-6W. You state that on Pebruary 12, 1958 a C-122-A was submitted in triplicate reporting annual deliverability test on subject well. Our records or files do not indicate that this test was ever received. Will you please re-submit the test in triplicate to this office.

The annual test that you mention was conducted on this well was not conducted during the annual testing season; therefore it will be necessary that the well have an annual deliverability test conducted between now and the end of 1958. The annual test will take the place of the initial test for our purposes at present.

You also asked whether or not it will be necessary to run future deliverability tests on your #2 Bolack B well. At present our rules and regulations provide that any well which produces less than 1,000,000 cubic feet of gas per month over a six-months period shall be exempt from annual deliverability test. This exemption classification is given the well by the Commission after studying production records. In the case of your well, I would certainly think that no deliverability test beyond the 1958 test will be required unless the well's producing capacity improves.
