Gentlemen:

In accordance with Order No. R-565-C, Rule 6 (B), request is made for administrative approval of a non-standard gas proration unit for Northwest Production Corporation's "S" Well 7-4, which is located in the NW/4 of the NW/4 of Section 4, Township 24 North, Range 4 West, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

The proposed non-standard unit for "S" Well 7-4 consists of the NW/4 of said Section 4, including lots 3 and 4 contiguous to the NW/4, a total of 225 acres. The unorthodox size of the proposed unit is caused by a variation in the legal subdivision of the United States Public Land Survey, and it lies within a single governmental section, all of which is subject to an oil and gas lease in favor of Northwest Production Corporation. It is reasonable to presume that all of the non-standard unit is productive of gas.

According to our records, and as indicated on the attached plat, El Paso Natural Gas Company, Box 1492, El Paso, Texas, owns the mineral rights in Section 5, Township 24 North, Range 4 West and Sections 32 and 33, Township 25 North, Range 4 West, which offset our "S" Well 7-4. Copy of this request for approval of a non-standard gas proration unit is being given this operator by registered mail.
