Section 3: NW/4

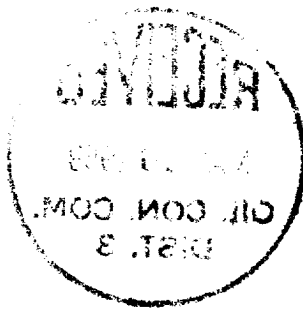
It is understood that this unit is to be dedicated to your Canyon Largo Unit Well No. 19, located 990 feet from the North and West lines of said Section 3.
