Dear Sir:

Reference is made to your letter of October 26, 1962 inquiring as to the over production status of your Federal #17-32 lease in Rio Arriba County.

I have reviewed the status of this well as far back as July 1, 1962, and find that it had a cumulative over produced status of 493 barrels as of July 1. The well had an allowable of 2170 barrels in July and produced 1929 barrels, so that its over produced status as of August 1 was reduced to 252 barrels. As you have stated in your letter, the over production during August was 376 barrels, so that the cumulative over production at the end of August was 628 barrels.

Allowable and production records are maintained on a cumulative basis by the New Mexico Commission. Under production during any month may not be carried forward into another month except for the purpose of making up previous over production. It is possible that this point may be giving you trouble in maintaining legal storage records.

Dear Mr. Williams:

Thank you for

your letter of October 20, 1969, regarding the oil  
conservation status of your Federal #14-12 lease in Rio Arriba County.

I have reviewed the status of this well as far as oil is  
produced and find that it has a potential for producing oil at  
least 100 barrels per day. The well has an average of 2500 barrels per day and produced  
1000 barrels. It has been producing oil at least 1 year and  
to 250 barrels. As you have stated in your letter, the conservation  
status of this well is being reviewed and the conservation status will be  
the end of August and 100 barrels.

Available and production records are maintained on a monthly basis by  
the New Mexico Conservation. Under production during any month will not be  
carried forward into another month except for the purpose of making up  
production over production. It is possible that this point may be rising  
for possible in maintaining legal storage records.
