NE/SW/4 Section 33 - 25-N - 5-W


Plats on form C-128 (New Mexico) are attached to four of the copies of the notices.

None are available for the other two - as they were attached to forms submitted yesterday which we understand have already been forwarded to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission at Aztec.

When you forward the Gallup notices herewith, please ask them to disregard the "Dakota" notices submitted yesterday; and to substitute the plats attached to those by attaching to the Gallup notices - with the further request that they change the "Formation" from "Dakota" to "Gallup", the number of acres designated from "80" to "40" - the 40 designated to be the 40 around the well site in each case.
