SW/4 SW/4 Section 33 - Township 25-North, Range 5-West
Rio Arriba Country, New Mexico
Otero Gallup Oil Pool.

As mentioned in our telephone conversation of yesterday, no oil has been produced from the captioned well since June - pursuant to letter of June 18th written by Mr. A. R. Kendrick, carbon copy of which is attached to the original of this letter.

The San Juan Drilling Company (Incorporated in Delaware), Operator of the well, has now installed the equipment necessary to deliver the gas, has made a contract with El Paso Natural Gas Company to sell the gas to them, and the rate schedule has been approved by the Federal Power Commission. We, therefore, expect to be able to produce the oil without flaring gas within the next day or two.

We shall appreciate it if you will lift the suspension of our Form C-110, Certificate of Compliance and Authorization to Transport Oil from the captioned well.

You suggested yesterday that I write you a letter, hence this communication. Should you desire a new Form C-110 or other papers, please let me know, and we shall endeavor to provide what is necessary.

Dear Mr. Neal:

Special pool rules have been established for the Otero-Gallup Oil Pool in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, by Order R-1237 effective August 13, 1958. A copy of said order is enclosed.

Paragraph (4) prohibits flaring or venting of gas from the pool.

Therefore Form C-110, Certificate of Compliance and Authorization to Transport Oil for your Jicarilla #1, Unit M-Section 33-25N-5W is hereby suspended, effective June 18, 1959. Authorization to produce and run oil cannot be granted until either a gas connection has been made or an exception to Order R-1237 (4) has been granted.
