We have received two copies of Federal Notice of Intention to Drill for your A-14 well located 1125 feet from the North Line and 450 feet from the East Line of Section 14-25N-1W. This is a non-standard location for either an oil or gas well, as it is only 450 feet from the quarter-quarter section line of the 40 acres on which it is located. We would, therefore, not be able to approve production from this well without notice and hearing if production is secured.

Therefore, any approval given you on this location by the U.S.G.S. is subject to the above requirements.
