 - 6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED!

That the applicant, Benson-Hontin-Grear Drilling Corporation, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject gas into the Mancos formation through the following described wells for purposes of pressure maintenance, to wit:

Canada Ojitos Unit-Hell-Ho. - 5 located in Unit B of Section 18, Township 25 North, Range 1 East, EMPH, Canada-Ojitos-Unit-Well-No:-17 located in Unit C of Section 1, Township 24 North, Range 1 Wost, IMPN, and danada Ojito Unit Well no. 18 located in Unit C of Section 5, Township 25 North, Range 1 Esst, MPM,
