Would you please refer to the following well:

The Superior Oil Co #1-7 Sealy Government
SE 7-25N-6W (O), Canyon Largo Pictured Cliffs, Rio Arriba
County, New Mexico

In view of the fact that this office does not keep a record of return deliverability tests I am not able to say whether or not I returned this well to you for recalculation. I am, however, presuming that it was one of those returned.

In any event we have set a delinquent date for receipt of 1955 deliverability tests made in the month of May, 1955 to be July 1, 1955. I must advise you that a test on the above noted well has not been received, accepted or posted in this office to date.

Section A. Paragraph 2 of the NMOCC Order No. R-333-B states "the results of these annual tests shall be filed with the Commission on Form C-122-A within the month next after completion of such test." In order that you be in compliance with the above stated rule I suggest that you file the test in question as soon as possible.
