Gentlemen:

By letters dated March 14, 1978, and October 20, 1977, this office requested Sundry Notice, form 9-331, outlining your plans to commence drilling operations on well No. 8 Burro Canyon, located in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. 21, T. 24 N., R. 4 W., NNPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, on Jicarilla Contract No. 363.

Application for Permit to Drill the subject well was approved May 28, 1976. A recent inspection found that an access road and well pad had not been constructed, and that the well has not been drilled.

Your Application for Permit to Drill well No. 8 Burro Canyon has been rescinded this date and is returned herewith. If at some later date you decide to drill at this location, it will be necessary for you to file a new Application for Permit to Drill.
