Your letter of March 17, 1977 indicates that you plan to use the IP Test on your AXI Apache "N" # 11 in R-12- 25 N, 17 W., Mesaverde well, in lieu of a Deliverability test. This will not work. NMOCC Order R-1670-S states that an initial deliverability test must be submitted within 90 days of First Delivery to secure an allowable for the well.

An IP Test is an optional test and should be submitted if taken. The deliverability test is used to assign an allowable to the well. If a deliverability test is done timely, the initial deliverability will serve as the annual deliverability for the current year. All new completions must be tested annually for the first three years. After that they are tested when scheduled, every other year.
