This plan is submitted with the Application for Permit to Drill the above well. The purpose of the plan is to describe the location of the proposed well, the proposed construction activities and operations plan, the magnitude of necessary surface disturbance involved and the procedures to be followed in rehabilitating the surface after completion of the operation so that a complete appraisal can be made of the environmental effects associated with the operation.

4. Location of Existing and/or proposed facilities:

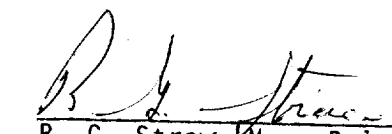
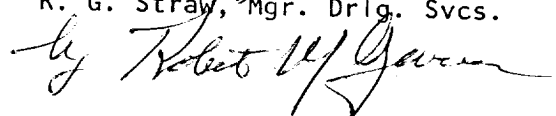
Existing facilities in this area have their own batteries and flowlines. In the event of a producing well, shown on topo map, tanks will be installed approx. 200' from well site, utilizing same pad designed and built to drill well.
5. Location and type of water supply:
 - A. No water supply is available for drilling purposes. Water will be trucked to well site and stored in lined pit.
 - B. No water well is to be drilled.
6. Source of construction materials:

No construction materials are anticipated to be needed for this well.
7. Method for handling of waste material:
 - A. Drilling cuttings will be disposed of in pits.
 - B. Drilling fluids will be allowed to evaporate in pits.
 - C. Fluids produced during drilling operations will be put in pits.
 - D. Current laws and regulations pertaining to human waste will be complied with.
 - E. Garbage and other waste material will be finced and destroyed in compliance with regulations.
 - F. Location after drilling will be filled, leveled and reseeded.

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8. Ancillary Facilities:
A. No camps or airstrips are required.

A. After completion of drilling, all areas will be cleaned, leveled and reseeded depending on weather conditions as soon as possible.

B. Sagebrush, blue grama, Narrow leaf Yucca, Broom snakeweed, & prickly pear cactus
