3. Ran 6 joints 8 5/8", 24# K-85 casing landed at 310 KB. Mudco cemented with 250 sks Class "B" containing 2% Ca Cl and 3# Flocele. Plug down at 11:20 p.m. 7-5-78. Circulated 15 bbls cement.
4. Drilled to 7000' KB on 7-19-78.
5. Ran Schlumberger IES, GR-FDC/NL/CAL logs, Log TD 7004.
6. Ran 34 jts, 1096', 4 1/2" 11.0# ST&C Casing. 64 jts, 2000' 4 1/2", 10.5# ST&C casing; Baker 2 stage cement collar; 116 jts, 3780', 4 1/2", 10.5# ST&C casing & 1 jt. 30", 4 1/2", 11.0# ST&C casing landed at 6999 KB. Top of Stage Cementer at 3811 KB.
7. B-J cemented 1st. stage w/500 gal mud sweep, 500 sks 50-50 pozmix, 60 gal 2 tail in with 715 sks 50-50 pozmix, 20 gal. Displaced w/50 bbl water & 60 1/2 bbl mud. Full returns through-out job. Dropped bomb and opened cementer. Circulated 4 hrs. Cemented 2nd. stage w/1715 sks 65/35 pozmix 5% gel & tail in w/50 sks Class "B" neat. Displaced w/50 1/2 bbl water. Bumped plug w/2300 psi & closed stage tool. Released pressure. held o.k. 1st. stage circulated 50 sks, 2nd. stage circulated 300 sks to pit. Job completed 11:00 a.m. 7-20-78

Instructions
