This well was drilled and competed in the Pictured Cliffs formation in 1978 and first produced in 1979. It has always been a marginal producer, with a cumulative production of 25,644 MCF. In recent years production has ranged from 2 to 5 MCF/D. The well is no longer capable of producing against line pressure.

Alpine Oil & Gas Corporation is interested in salvaging this well by plugging back and recompleting in the Fruitland coal. Alpine Oil & Gas Corporation believes that the Fruitland coal section is covered with cement, and that the Fruitland coal is capable of production.
