

AXI APACHE M No.6

LAND STATUS: Jicarilla Apache Tribal Lands

LOCATION: NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 14, Township 25 North ; Range 4 West, N.M.P.M. Rio Arriba County, New Mex. The well will be 1500 feet from the North line and 1650 feet from the West line of Section 14. A 300 X 300 foot area was surveyed. See Figure 2.

ACCESS: 2,500 feet long and 20 feet wide approaching the well from the North.

TERRAIN: Broken terrace with westerly drainage, alluvial surface deposits and sandstone outcrops.

SOIL: Sandy loam

VEGETATION: Juniper, piñon, mountain mahogany, bitterbrush, blue grama, Gamble's Oak, sagebrush, Yucca baccata, prickly pear

CULTURAL RESOURCES: No cultural resources were found.

RECOMMENDATIONS: Archaeological clearance is recommended.

LAND STATUS: Jicarilla Apache Tribal Land

LOCATION: NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 11, Township 25 North ; Range 4 West, N.M.P.M., Rio Arriba County, New Mex. The well will be 990 feet from the South line and 1650 feet from the East line of Section 11. A 300 X 300 foot area was surveyed. See Figure 2.

ACCESS: 1,500 feet long and 20 feet wide approaching the location from the west.

TERRAIN: Level valley slope with south southeasterly drainage, alluvial surface deposits and sandstone outcrops.

SOIL: Sandy clay loam

VEGETATION: Juniper, piñon, snakeweed, rabbitbrush, wolfberry, sagebrush, bitterbrush, blue grama, Yucca baccata, Eriogonum spp.

CULTURAL RESOURCES: No cultural resources were found.

RECOMMENDATIONS: Archaeological clearance is recommended.
