

Abstract

An archaeological clearance survey was performed on August 22, 1978 for Continental Oil Company by the Division of Conservation Archaeology of the San Juan County Archaeological Research Center and Library. The survey involved nine well pads and associated access roads on lands under the jurisdiction of the Jicarilla Apache Tribe.

Since the cultural resources found are not to be directly or indirectly impacted by the proposed construction, archaeological clearance has been recommended for all areas.
