

Pursuant to the request of Mr. A. R. Kendrick, Supervisor, District No. 3, and pursuant to Rule 3 of the Special Rules and FEB 2 0 1979 Regulations for the West Lindrith Gallup-OIL CON. COM. Dakota Oil Pool of the Oil Conservation Division, Energy and Minerals Department of the State of New Mexico, ARCO Oil and Gas Company, Division of Atlantic Richfield Company, the Applicant, submits this letter application for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 2 of said Rules and Regulations for the drilling of a non-standard spacing and proration unit and shows as follows:

- 3. The NE¼ of said section, township and range is not a standard size quarter section of 160 acres under the United States Public Land Survey but instead consists of 218.95 acres, more or less.
- 4. Rule 3 of the special rules and regulations states that the Commission may grant administratively an exception to the 160-acre standard unit size established by Rule 2 without notice and without hearing by submitting an application.
- 5. By his signature below the undersigned verifies that all operators offsetting the proposed non-standard unit have been furnished with separate notification of this application this date by depositing same, in the United States mail, postage prepaid, certified mail, return receipt requested.
- 6. Pursuant to Rule 6 of the Special Rules and Regulations, based upon an allowable of 4.77 for a standard 160-acre spacing and proration unit, the proposed unit consisting of 218.95 acres more or less should be assigned, the appropriate increased allowable.
