

WORK-OVER PROJECT - Schalk 41 Well No. 2A

On May 16, 1996 a plunger lift system was installed on the Schalk 41 #2A to remove produced water from the wellbore more efficiently and allow for increased production.

B & R Wireline Service was used to first broach the tubing and to run and set a bottom hole spring assembly at the end of the tubing. A plunger was dropped from the surface and a full control panel was installed along with a psiton catcher. Third party services were released once it was determined that the plunger would surface.
