Gentlemen:

Your July 17, 1992 letter requested a response from Conoco concerning our plans for either abandoning or returning to production the AXI Apache N Wells No. 11A, 12A, 14A, and 16A. Intents to perform mechanical integrity tests for temporary abandonment have been filed on all four of these wells, but the tests were never done nor subsequent intents for temporary abandonment filed. These wells, the date of the "intent" filing, and the current status of these wells are as follows:

<u>Well No.</u>	<u>Date of Intent</u>	<u>Status</u>
AXI Apache N #11A B -12-25-4	1/88	Mechanical Integrity Test scheduled 9/92
AXI Apache N #12A L -11-25-4	2/87	Currently producing this well
AXI Apache N #14A K -1-25-4	3/92	Mechanical Integrity Test scheduled 9/92
AXI Apache N #16A C -12-25-4	3/92	Currently returning to production

Well Nos. 11A and 14A will be tested during September, 1992 and a subsequent notice requesting temporary abandonment filed, while Well Nos. 12A and 16A should be reclassified as producing wells.
