On May 23, 1996, Harold TeCube of the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Jicarilla Agency, and I inspected the above referenced well for Final Abandonment Haynes #11Y, T. 24 N., R 5 W., 905 FSL & 1050' FWL, Section 15. The location had a vertical pipe projecting out of the ground near the dry hole marker and production equipment left on the location. This office returned the Final Abandonment Notice (FAN) that had been submitted by Conoco.

Follow up inspections and phone calls to your field personnel have resulted in verifying the equipment and riser pipe have been removed. The riser pipe was removed by your field personnel at the end of June and the pad is revegetated with reclamation complete. Please submit a FAN Sundry, so we can approve the well for final abandonment. If you have any questions please feel free to call me at (505) 761-8786.
