Procedure for Plugging:

11/06/97

To plug and abandon well, record shows Nacimiento perforated at 2351' to 2361' and 2370' to 2375' with TD at 2397'.

- 1. Propose to set cement retainer between 2360' and 2390' (depending on top of tubing above derrick floor). Maximum open hole below retainer 1.3 barrels, will skeeth with 2.6 barrels minimum using 15 sacks.
- Spot cement plug from retainer to 100 feet above top perforation using minimum of 10 sacks cement. (Note: Ojo Alamo and Fruitland formations are 1000 feet below perforations in this well.)
- J. Spot cement from 174ft. to the surface.
