On September 20, 1993 at approximately 10:00pm an unauthorized person or persons tried to remove a plug from a 1" valve connected to a drip tank on a pressurized natural gas pipeline, with the intent of theft or vandalism. In doing this they removed the valve instead of the plug leaving the line open and blowing natural gas to the atmosphere. They then exited the location from the southeast through an open field. The open line was found at approximately 8:00am by an El Paso switcher and was repaired. The incident was reported to Al Yepa with the BLM Cuba, N.M. field office at 11:00pm.
