As discussed with W. K. Cooper of your Company on May 5, 1983, the subject APDs are rescinded and returned due to drilling not being commenced within a six month extension period following the original approval date.

You are required to request surface rehabilitation instructions from this office if construction activities occurred on the referenced drill sites. If this office does not receive comment within 15 days, it will presume that no construction occurred and proceed accordingly. Later discovery that construction activities have in fact occurred, will result in assessment of liquidated damages.
