
Gentlemen:

M.R. Schalk hereby requests administrative approval of a Non-Standard Proration Unit for the above referenced well, which currently has forty (40) acres dedicated to it under the old Ojito-Gallup/Dakota Oil Pool.

As the Ojito-Gallup/Dakota Oil Pool has been abolished and the West Lindrith-Gallup/Dakota Oil Pool has been extended by Commission Order R-8544, which now requires that 160 acres be dedicated to a well, we are requesting the approval so that we may continue to produce with only our dedicated 40 acres without threat of a shut-in.




